The underground system allows for cars to be transported from street level down beneath the building automatically without a parking attendant. Thus the owner of the car is the sole operator. To retrieve their vehicle, the patron presents their electronic card on the elevator going to the lobby and the vehicle is automatically delivered to the entry/exit compartment at street level.
